


**Welcome to the Brotherhood**

Morehouse consistently has 10 to 15 graduates enrolled at the Harvard Business School. Typically, 30 to 35 Morehouse students gain acceptance to medical school each year. And Morehouse Men are highly sought after by Fortune 500 companies and leading organizations worldwide.

Morehouse graduates approximately **500** students each year, traditionally conferring bachelor's degrees on more African American men than any other college or university in the United States.
