AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to advance enrollment of certain students

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 18 of section 3302 of 1 the education law, as 2 added by section 1 of part A of chapter 328 of the laws of 2014, is 3 amended to read as follows: 18. "Uniformed service" or "uniformed services" 4 means the Army, Navy, 5 Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, Coast Guard as well as the Commissioned Corps of the National Oceanic and 6 Atmospheric Administration, and 7 Public Health Services. § 2.
