TechGirls will bring 20 American young women (ages 15-17) to join 7-9 TechGirls from each participating Central Asia and the Middle East and North Africa (MENA) country for an exciting 16 days of quality tech training and international friendship on the campus of Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, VA. Participants will collaborate on tech projects by day and participate in stimulating cross-cultural dialogues and fun activities at night!

Your scholarship is fully inclusive of courses, programming, housing and meals, staff supervision and ground transport for sightseeing. Participants are only responsible for transportation to and from Virginia Tech.

U.S. Youth Ambassadors, this is your chance to collaborate with female STEM leaders from around the globe and gain tech skills that will inspire you to pursue your dreams. During your stay at Virginia Tech, located in beautiful Blacksburg, VA, you will select one of four technical instruction class options including Java Programming, Cybersecurity, and other possible options such as Business Information Technologies and Data and Model Based Analytics. You will also meet with a variety of department leaders conducting cutting-edge research.

TechGirls is a U.S. Department of State initiative that brings young women from Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestinian Territories, Tajikistan, Tunisia and Uzbekistan to the U.S. for a threeweek international exchange program designed to empower young girls from the Middle East and North Africa, Central Asia, and the United States to pursue careers in science and technology. A highlight of their stay is meeting the US Youth Ambassadors as you live and learn together at Virginia Tech.
