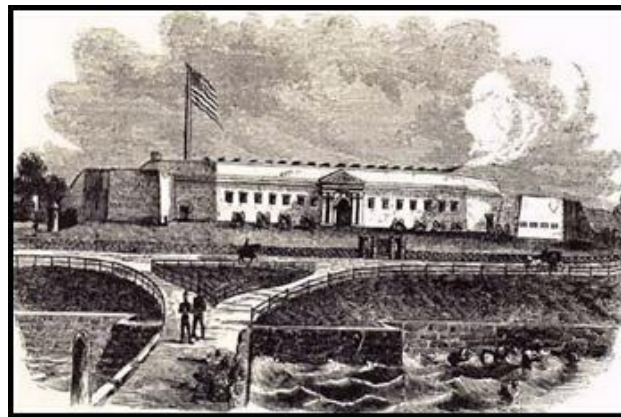

HISTORY

During the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, the United States was defended by a system of fortifications designed to protect its harbors and strategic waterways. With its cornerstone laid in 1825, Fort Hamilton was part of this network and was the first Third System fortification built in New York City. The fort had two missions. The first was to support actions against enemy warships seeking to pass through the Narrows. Its second was to defend itself and the other Narrows forts against land based infantry attacks.

During the Civil War batteries of powerful smooth-bore Rodman guns were added to Fort Hamilton's defenses. Between 1898 and 1905 Fort Hamilton's defenses were again upgraded to include large caliber disappearing guns and mortars. During World Wars I & II, Fort Hamilton served as a key defensive position and a major point of embarkation. Nevertheless Fort Hamilton's defensive mission came to an end during the Cold War, and the garrison came to support other activities.

Today the United States Army Garrison Fort Hamilton stands as the 4th oldest continuously serving military post in the United States, and the only active duty military installation in the City of New York.

MEMBERSHIP

The Fort Hamilton Community Club is a military, all rank, dues paying membership club. Membership cards are required to identify eligible users. Authorized Membership is open to all Active Duty, Retired Military, Reservist, National Guard, DoD Employees, Federal Employees, Veterans Affairs, NYPD, FDNY, and Foreign Military Personnel.

It is the sole responsibility of each member to update credit card information such as expiration date change or new cards. All new memberships require one year, non refundable, advance dues.
